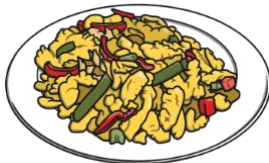


Key Vocabulary

island	an area of land completely surrounded by water
country	an area of land with a defined edge
sea	a sea is smaller than an ocean and usually located where the land and ocean meets
valley	a low area of land between hills or mountains
cliff	a tall, steep rock usually found on the coast
coast	the part of the land near the sea
vegetation	plants
city	a very large town
port	a manmade place where boats and ships dock to deliver goods
harbour	a place on the coast where boats stop to settle or for shelter
